FACT SHEET

Spiritual Growth:

Students participate in weekly Chapel services led by area pastors and the CTK principal, daily devotions, daily prayers, and daily religious instruction.

Students in grades 7-8 receive Confirmation instruction taught by the pastors of Immanuel Lutheran Church, Sebewaing, and St. Paul Lutheran Church, Unionville.

Academics:

Christ the King students participate in Northwest Evaluation Assessments (NWEA).

CTK offers departmentalized classrooms in grades 5-8, preparing students for a smoother transition to high school.

Academic Support:

Christ the King employs an academic specialist, certified in Evidence-Based Learning Instruction (EBLI), who works with individual or small groups of students to assist them in reading, math, and other subject areas.

Accreditation:

Christ the King is currently completing the accreditation process for the National Lutheran Schools Accreditation (NLSA) and Michigan Association of Non-Public Schools (MANS).

Athletics:

Christ the King offers an interscholastic sports program for students in grades 5-8.

Girls' sports offered include basketball, co-ed soccer, track and field, and volleyball.

Boys' sports offered include basketball, co-ed soccer, and track and field.

CTK offers a co-op with USA schools to offer football to boys in grades 7-8.

CTK competes in the Tri-County Lutheran League which includes sixteen schools within the greater Tri-City area.

Early Childhood:

CTK supports Little Knights Preschool, located at the Unionville Campus, and offers either half or full-day learning programs.

Parents may choose 2, 3, or 5 days per week.

Latchkey is available before and after school has closed for the day.

Faculty:

CTK faculty has an average of 17.5 years of teaching experience.

Four faculty hold advanced degrees.

Five faculty hold Lutheran Teaching Diploma.

Four faculty hold a Lutheran colloquy.

Music:

Kindergarten and first grade sing in Cherub Choir and play handbells.

Students in grades 2-4 sing in the Children's Choir.

Students in grades 5-8 may choose either Chorale (5-8), music appreciation (gr. 5-6), music theory (gr. 7-8), or handbells (required for 6th grade, optional for 7th and 8th grades).

School Activities:

Throughout the school year, students of CTK may participate in an academic fair, a Christmas program, choir concerts, field trips, the Geography Bee, FIRST LEGO League and FIRST Tech Challenge (Robotics), a Bay area music festival, servant projects, a Spring musical.

Technology:

Christ the King integrates technology into curriculum. Both school campuses host a computer lab.

At our Unionville campus, students use I pads to support their learning.

At our Sebewaing campus, each student is issued a Chromebook to enrich their learning experience at Christ the King Lutheran School.
